The Holocaust was perpetrated by a specific total and organized system of Nazi Germany and its collaborators with the aim of annihilating the Jewish people, women and children from the face of the Earth. The primary motivation for the Holocaust was the racist antisemitic ideology between 1932 and 1945. Nazi ideology presented a policy of persecution that discriminated the Jews of their rights and property, and later branded them as non-human and Jewish women under their rule into degraded areas. In the end of 1941, the policy had developed into an overall extermination, systematic genocide. The Holocaust is the answer to "Solutions to the Jewish Question". These policies gained broad support in Germany and across Europe. In 1941, the Nazis began Jewish deportation to camps. Nazi Germany designated the Jews as "enemies of the state" and "undesirable" for total extermination. Alongside the mass extermination, the Jews were deported to camps where they were subjected to forced labor. In the end of 1941, some 2.5 million Jews had been deported to the camps. In the end of 1945, some 1.5 million Jews had been murdered.
