General information

- The Yad Vashem site is open Sunday-Wednesday 09:00-17:00, Thursday 09:00-20:00, and Friday and the eve of holidays 09:00-14:00.
- Entry to the Holocaust History Museum will be permitted up to one hour before closing time. Entrance is free of charge.
Due to the large number of visitors, we recommend that you visit in the afternoon hours.
- Children under the age of 10 will not be permitted entry to the Holocaust History Museum.
- Tours in the museum will be conducted with the use of a group audio system, available in the Visitors Center.

- After your reservation has been processed, you will receive a group entry permit which you must present at the group desk in the Visitors Center
- Reservation applications will be answered within 2 weeks of receipt
- **Rules of Conduct in the Holocaust History Museum:** Food, drink, and bags are not permitted inside the Museum. (They may be checked in our cloakroom free of charge). Smoking and photography are forbidden inside the Museum.
